Richard A. Miller *"How to live off the Grid for 30 days?"*

How to build a sustainable lifeboat to survive when the electricity goes out. What needs to be done for "the day after tomorrow". Skills and tools to prepare food, water and other survival techniques for a disaster.

Special emphasis will be placed on dealing with mycotoxins, a fungal infestation that can be passed from grain crops to herd animals to humans, as well as the use of advanced reagents, including symbols, colors, crystals, and other specialized minerals.

Lutie Larsen *"Basic Skills in Radionics"*

- * What is a stick plate and how to dowse
- * Understanding amplitude and how to measure on a specific scale
- * Understanding and using various 'scales.'
- * Using the input/output areas
- * How to Measure and Balance a specific subject
- * 'Radionic' terminology (GV, reagent, negative/positive patterns etc)
- * Understanding and using various 'scales'.
